2. INCLUDE **5 PHOTOCOPIES** OF YOUR WORK.
3. MAKE SURE YOUR WORK IS TYPED OR WORD PROCESSED.
4. DO NOT WRITE YOUR NAME DIRECTLY ON YOUR WORK.
5. **FILL OUT THIS FORM AND ATTACH IT WITH A PAPERCLIP IN FRONT OF YOUR WORK AND YOUR 5 PHOTOCOPIES.**
